



Report on SASA Activity – March 2026

Theme: *Source Segregation and Zero Waste Lifestyles*

Date: 28-03-2026

Under the monthly SASA initiative for March 2026, an environmental awareness and campus action programme was organized on 28th March 2026 with the theme “**Source Segregation and Zero Waste Lifestyles.**” The programme aimed to educate students and staff on responsible waste management practices and to promote a plastic-free, clean campus through collective participation. The programme was conducted under the guidance of the Principal **Dr. Y. Sreelatha** and the Vice Principal **Dr. A. Kedari**. The SASA committee members who coordinated the activity included, **Dr. M. Hari Prasad**, **Dr. B. Vendantham**, and **N. Srinivasa Rao**. More than **100 students** along with **20 teaching and non-teaching staff members** actively participated in the programme. NSS volunteers played a key role in mobilizing students and executing the activities.





Programme Highlights

1. Awareness Pledge

The programme began with an environmental pledge titled “**My Waste – My Responsibility.**” Participants resolved to practice waste segregation at source, avoid single-use plastics, and adopt zero-waste habits in daily life.

2. Classroom and Campus Cleaning Drive

Students and staff jointly undertook a systematic cleaning of classrooms, corridors, and the college premises. This activity emphasized dignity of labour and collective responsibility for maintaining a clean environment.

3. Plastic Collection and Zero Plastic Campaign

A special drive was conducted to identify and collect plastic waste from different parts of the campus. The campaign strongly promoted the message of a **Zero Plastic Campus.**

4. Waste Segregation Practice

Separate bins were arranged and demonstrated for:

- Biodegradable waste
- Non-biodegradable waste
- Plastic waste

Students were educated on how proper segregation at source reduces landfill burden and supports recycling.

5. Poster Display and Awareness Messages

Posters conveying messages on waste segregation, zero waste lifestyle, and environmental protection were displayed by the Principal and SASA team members to reinforce awareness visually across the campus.

Outcome of the Programme

- Students gained practical understanding of **source segregation of waste.**
- Awareness on **zero waste lifestyle** and **plastic reduction** was significantly improved.
- The campus environment was made visibly cleaner and plastic-free.
- The activity instilled a sense of **environmental responsibility** and teamwork among students.

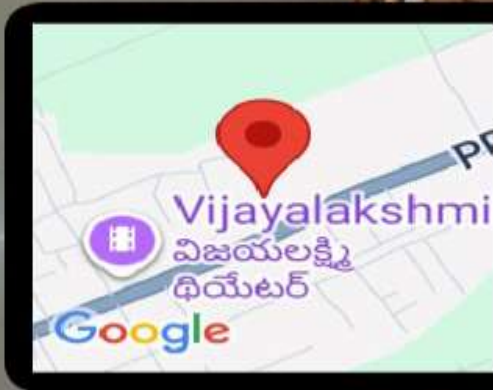
